Noah's Ark

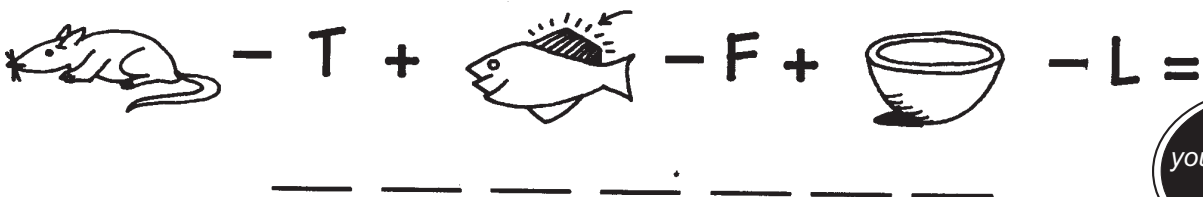


Many years after Adam and Eve lived, the people had become very wicked. So God told a man named Noah to build a boat called an ark.
